What radio stations are in Bangui?

In Bangui, UN-sponsored Radio Ndeke Luka ("bird of luck") provides balanced output, and rebroadcasts international news programming. Other radio and TV stations are run by the state-run Radiodiffusion-Télévision Centrafricaine and provide little coverage of the political opposition.

Why are base stations an inevitability?

Those are equipped with large towers and antennas that transmit and receive radio signals from wireless devices.

What is a wireless base station?

A base station represents an access point for a wireless device to communicate within its coverage area. It usually connects the device to other networks or devices through a dedicated high bandwidth wire of fiber optic connection. Base stations typically have a transceiver, capable of sending and receiving wireless signals;
